



Firebird MKA 1919 Buttstock Adapter

NOTE: As in all cases when handling a firearm, make sure the firearm is unloaded and has no magazine or round in the chamber.

Please read the complete instructions before proceeding.

Disassemble the MKA 1919 and separate the upper receiver from the lower receiver being careful not to damage the ramp. This accomplished by holding the bolt back during separation. See Jim's video for more help. <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s9uhfR0aWXA>

When you have the upper receiver ready to cut, you can follow these instructions. Cut the Buttstock 90° from the top horizontal rail on the receiver. Make the finished cut between .900 and 1.100 from vertical top of edge of upper receiver. I recommend you cut it long and file to finished dimension.
